The paper should be submitted both in .doc and .pdf format. The submitted .pdf document will be used as reference. The camera-ready journal will be prepared in .pdf format by the editors. An accurate formatting is required in order to reduce subsequent changes of aspect to a minimum. The paper should be prepared on A4 paper (210 x 297 mm) and it must contain an abstract not exceeding 100 words.

Only papers written in English will be published in the journal (please, use English spell-check).
