INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

Submission of a manuscript to the journal signifies that work has not been previously published and that it has not been submitted or accepted for publication elsewhere.

Submitted manuscripts must be written in English and should be in Microsoft Word format. (Times New Roman 10 p, single spacing). The length of manuscripts is limited to: 20 pages for scientific papers, 32 pages for surveys, 12 pages for application papers, 6 pages for communications. First page must contain:

- 1) Title of paper,
- 2) Name, affiliation and mailing address (including e-mail) of each author,
- 3) Abstract (not exceeding 150 words),
- 4) Keywords (not exceeding five),
- 5) Footnotes (if desired) containing acknowledgment of financial or other support.

Manuscripts should include: an introductory part with representation and analysis of the problem(s) under consideration and current state-of-the-art of the existing solutions, exposition of the investigation and comments on the results obtained, evaluation of the contribution indicating advantages, limitations and possible directions for future research. It is desirable to focus explicitly on the results the author find more important and to discuss them in the context of current research rather than just present the author's work with much statistical data as the main part of the text. The Abstract should be clear, concise and informative. Desirable topics: aim of the research, methodology/approach, main results, originality/value. References should be numbered and listed at the end of manuscript. The reference number in square brackets is used to cite a reference, e.g. [5]. For the style of overall layout see the document Paper preparation template.

Author(s) should send to the Editorial office on address cit.bas.bg@gmail.com a Word file with the manuscript, allowing prepress processing. It should include the authors preferred address for correspondence.
