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LANGUAGE

English.

All the writing should be clear, concise, and logical. Appropriate academic language should be used. At the same time, the language should not impede scientific meaning or cause confusion.

FEE

Mental Health: Global Challenges Journal operates under the Conference Model, integrating the benefits of conference participation and scholarly publication. This model ensures high standards in research dissemination, rigorous peer review and editorial processes, and enhances the visibility and networking opportunities for authors and conference participants. Additionally, we welcome high-quality submissions from researchers and practitioners outside of these conferences. This dual approach ensures that our content is both relevant and diverse, reflecting the latest advancements and research in the field.

Conference/Publication Fees To support the sustainability and quality of our publication process, we have established conference/publication fees. These fees (370 EUR per article) help cover the costs of organizing conferences, administrative and operational expenses, and ensure the quality of the publication process. They also contribute to making research widely accessible. This model allows us to provide a platform for researchers to present their work to a wide audience and subsequently publish their findings in our journal. We offer fee waivers and discounts to support a diverse range of contributors.

Guidelines

- **Conference Submission:** Authors can submit their papers to the conference first. Accepted papers will be considered for publication in the journal.

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Payment of Fees Only if your manuscript is accepted will you be required to pay the conference/publication fee

TYPES OF PUBLICATIONS

The journal accepts manuscripts such as theoretical articles, research articles, reviews, case-studies, extended abstracts

SUBMISSION OF PUBLICATIONS

Submissions should be sent as 2 separate files:

1. [Title page](#) with author's information
2. [Main text](#) - without author's information.

The preferred format is *.rtf. All manuscripts should be generally outlined and edited to conform to the APA writing style.

All submissions will be peer reviewed before entering the publication process.

All the data in manuscripts should correspond with the strict application of the scientific method to ensure robust and unbiased experimental design, methodology, analysis, interpretation and reporting of results. This includes full transparency in reporting experimental details so that others may reproduce and extend the findings.

Important. The volume of paper – including figures and references – must not exceed 27 000 characters (15 pages of typescript)

The abstract should contain 150-300 words
